# **Recipe of the Month**

## **Donkey Bombs (aka Donkey Balls)**



#### **Ingredients:**

2 packages crescent rolls8 oz cream cheese16 oz breakfast sausage1/4 tsp garlic powder1 small onion minced

## **Directions:**

Preheat oven to 375 degrees.

Brown sausage, breaking into crumbs.

Add diced onion and garlic powder until onion translucent.

Add cream cheese and blend over low heat until melted and combined.

Unroll crescent rolls and separate.

Place a small scoop of mixture onto each crescent, and roll up and seal.

Place finished bombs onto baking sheet 2 inches apart.

Bake for 12 - 15 minutes (browned, but not burnt on bottom).

Serve hot.

## Alternate suggestions:

I had a small piece of green pepper that needed to be used, so I diced it up and added with the onions.

The second time I switched the plain cream cheese to a savory cream cheese flavor.

We have enjoyed these as a brunch item, as an accompaniment with quiche, and as an accompaniment with potato soup.

As a matter of fact, these freeze well and are easy to take out of freezer, thaw in fridge, then bake.
