Recipe of the Month

Blueberry Muffins Aunt Betty's



Ingredients

MUFFINS:

1/2 cup old-fashioned oats	1/2 cup orange juice
1 large egg, room temperature	1/2 cup canola oil
1/2 cup sugar	1-1/2 cups all-purpose flour
1 1/4 teaspoons baking powder	1/2 teaspoon salt
1/4 teaspoon baking soda	1 cup fresh or frozen blueberries

TOPPING:

2 tablespoons sugar	1/2 teaspoon ground cinnamon
---------------------	------------------------------

Directions

Combine oats and orange juice; let stand for 5 minutes.
Beat in the egg, oil and sugar until blended.
Combine flour, baking powder & soda, and salt.
Stir into oat mixture just until moistened.
Fold in blueberries.
Fill greased or paper-lined muffin cups two-thirds full.
Combine topping ingredients; sprinkle over batter.
Bake at 400° for 20-25 minutes or until a toothpick comes out clean.
Cool for 5 minutes before removing from pan to a wire rack.
Serve warm.

Note: I like to use 1 1/4 cups of blueberries to get more blueberries per muffin.

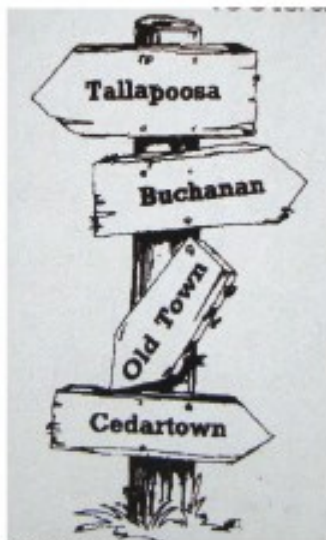

I have used the Reveille marque before in articles, and found one on the side of the building to use in this article, just to see if you are paying attention or not.

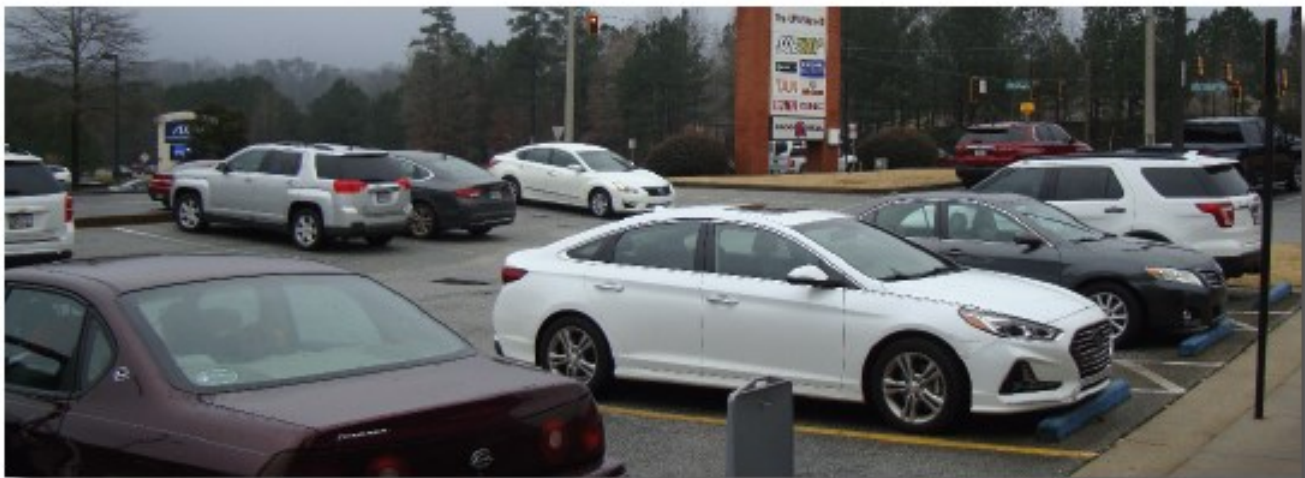

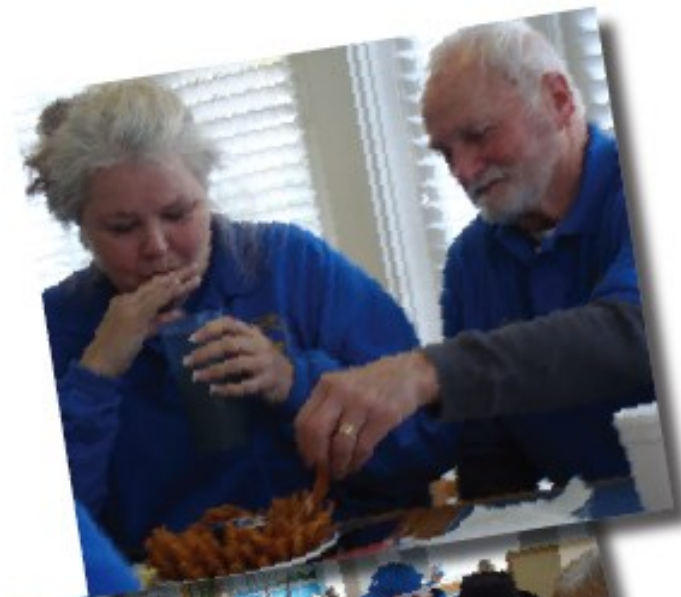
