Recipe of the Month

Blueberry Muffins Aunt Betty's



Ingredients MUFFINS:

1/2 cup old-fashioned oats1 large egg, room temperature1/2 cup sugar1 1/4 teaspoons baking powder1/4 teaspoon baking soda

1/2 cup orange juice1/2 cup canola oil1-1/2 cups all-purpose flour1/2 teaspoon salt1 cup fresh or frozen blueberries

TOPPING:

2 tablespoons sugar

1/2 teaspoon ground cinnamon

Directions

Combine oats and orange juice; let stand for 5 minutes. Beat in the egg, oil and sugar until blended. Combine flour, baking powder & soda, and salt. Stir into oat mixture just until moistened. Fold in blueberries. Fill greased or paper-lined muffin cups two-thirds full. Combine topping ingredients; sprinkle over batter. Bake at 400° for 20-25 minutes or until a toothpick comes out clean. Cool for 5 minutes before removing from pan to a wire rack. Serve warm.

Note: I like to use 1 ¼ cups of blueberries to get more blueberries per muffin.
