We did have a good show. Our horse won the Spring Celebration Grand Championship.

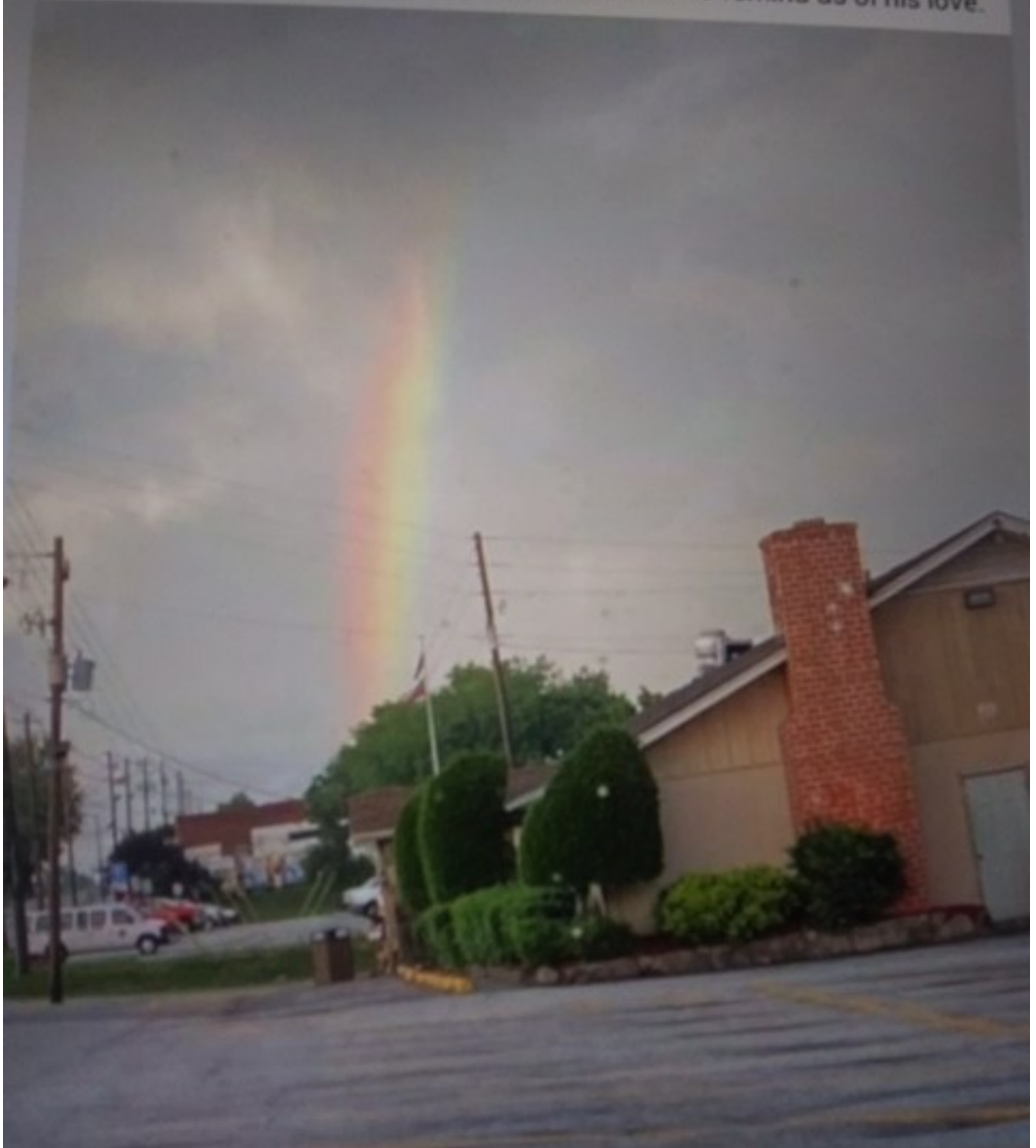

## Recipe of the Month

### **Butter Swim Biscuits**



#### Ingredients

2-1/2 cups all-purpose flour  
2 tablespoons sugar  
2 teaspoons kosher salt  
1 tablespoon plus 1 teaspoon baking powder  
4 tablespoons butter-flavored shortening  
1-1/2 cups cold buttermilk  
8 tablespoons unsalted butter, divided

#### Instructions

Preheat the oven to 450° F.  
Then, whisk the four dry ingredients together.  
Cut the shortening in until the mix becomes a bit crumbly.  
Bit by bit pour the buttermilk into the mix, working it into a dough as you go. When it becomes a cohesive dough stop adding buttermilk and mixing.  
It should be *just* wet enough.  
If there is not enough buttermilk, add a little more until the dough forms.  
Melt 7 tablespoons of the butter.  
Once melted, pour it into your baking dish.  
Place the dough into dish filling the space with an even layer of dough.  
You will see butter come over sides and onto top of dough.  
This is exactly what you want.  
Cut the biscuits before placing in the oven.  
Bake for 20 minutes.  
If top hasn't browned, turn on the broiler for a couple of minutes.  
Remove from the oven and let sit for a few minutes.
