Hope everyone is well. Here we are in the month of September, and I was looking for things to be getting better. But it looks like we are going the other direction.

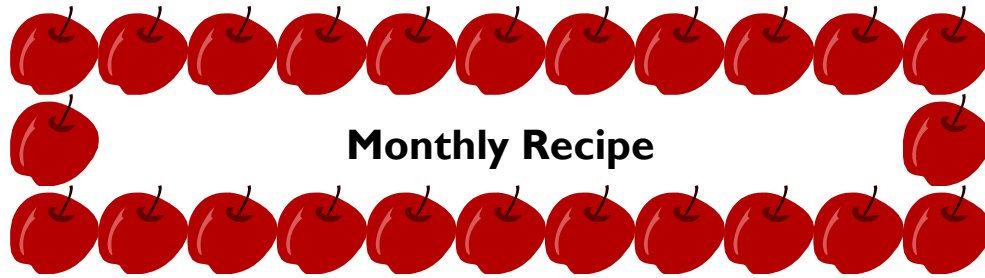
We still have a few events planned for the September.

Monthly Recipe

Whipping Cream Pound Cake



Ingredients

3 cups sugar
3 cups flour
1 cup butter
6 large eggs
1 cup heavy whipping cream
1 TBSP vanilla extract

Directions

Preheat oven to 325

Spray tube pan with non stick spray or grease and flour pan.

Using mixer, beat butter until smooth on medium, then add sugar and beat 2 to 3 minutes.

Add eggs, one at a time, beating well after each addition.

Add flour and heavy cream, alternating, beginning and ending with flour.

Add vanilla and mix on low until well combined.

Pour into prepared pan.

Bake 1 hour and 15-25 minutes. Test for doneness with a wooden pick.

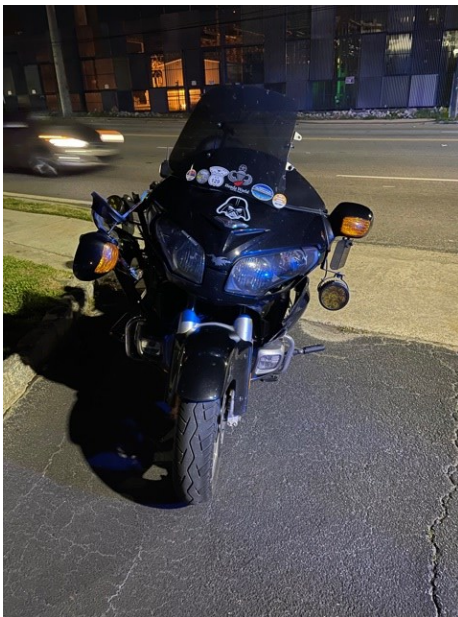
Cool in pan for 20-25 minutes before inverting onto a serving tray to cool completely.

I hit a Crachhead

I tell people I hit a crackhead. They hear me but the info doesn't really process so I show them a photo. Then it hits them and you hear comments like, "Oh, My God! ", "You actually hit a person!" "Is he dead?" I then reply, "He was alive when they put him in the ambulance. Todd at Bushtec in Jacksboro, Tennessee exclaimed, "You hit a white man!" I said, "Well, he was black when I hit him, so if he turned white, it must've been between the impact of the Gold Wing and the second impact of the ground".

I think about the training we go through when we attend the Advanced Riding Course (ARC) where you're taught to swerve to avoid an obstacle in the road. An excellent technique that all riders should master but it still doesn't guarantee safe passage in my instance. I have a part-time job that I work 4-5 times a month in my retirement. I was on the way into work and the time was 2245 hrs (10:45 pm for those of who are civilian personnel). Traffic was heavy right down from Mercedes Benz stadium after having just turned right off Bankhead. No sooner than I had turned onto Northside Drive, I was in the middle lane and noticed a guy stepping off the curb from my right oblivious to all the traffic and just strolled cross the street like he was at the mall.

I executed three or four movements simultaneously. I swerved, braked, flashed the headlights and blew the horn. I run Clearwater lights on the front of my bikes and the 2015 was no different. I run them at their lowest setting of 30% but when you hit the horn, they flash at 100%. The guy kept walking. I swerved again and he kept walking. I came in contact with him in the far-left lane just prior to the double yellow lines and knocked him back over in the direction from whence he came causing me to cross the double yellow lines. A car slammed on the brakes to prevent hitting me. The bikes engine shut down. My first thought was why? I hadn't dropped the bike and I hadn't hit the kill switch. You guys know how it is, we tend to remember when we do that.

I put the kickstand down and got off the bike, looked over at the guy laying in the street and was in the process of putting my Apple AirPods into my ear when an APD police vehicle pulled up and turned on his lights. So much for calling 911! I then went over to check on the person and he had a pulse. I overheard the lady who braked to avoid hitting me tell the police officer that she saw the whole thing and that I was blowing my horn, flashing my lights and trying to avoid the guy but he kept right on walking. When talking to the police officer, I made sure I showed him how the Clearwater lights worked.

Now back to my original question of why the engine had shut down. The impact caused \$7500 damage to the front end and the bike was totaled. The impact pushed the dashboard back and bent the ignition key and turned it to the off position. The damage prevented the handlebars from turning to the left. I rode the bike for a distance of 1 mile to the hotel where I worked just by leaning. Another day in the life.
